

# Single Stage

Single stage paints do not require a clearcoat for appearance or durability. They have U.V. protectors and clears mixed with their pigments. Metallic colors should not be shot with single stage paints. This is because there is no room for error. If you make a mistake, like a run or sag, you cannot sand or buff out that mistake without damaging the metallics. Then you are repainting. Solid colors are no problem. However, most people are still shooting basecoat clearcoat for solid colors too. You can clearcoat a single stage, but normally you need to wait until the next day and scuff it and shoot it.

Acrylic Enamel is the old main stay of single stage, but today acrylic urethane is our main product. It is much more user friendly.
